The **Open & Affordable Education Committee (OAEC)** supports student access to an affordable, high-quality education by advancing the use of affordable course materials, such as **Open Educational Resources (OER)**, **library licensed materials**, and **Immediate Access (IA) content**. Supported by the Office of the Senior Vice President and Provost, our team includes representatives from the University Library, ISU Book Store, Student Government, Center for Excellence in Learning & Teaching (CELT), Financial Aid, and faculty partners.

#### **Building Better Courses:**

Library and CELT staff have partnered to establish improved processes to help instructors who are redesigning courses to leverage the support available through the ISU Digital Press to create and disseminate OER.



#### **Providing Access to Content:**

Course Reserves and ISU Book Store staff are working together to ensure that students are not charged for materials in course packets that already are or could be made available through the library at no cost.



#### **Promoting Student Engagement:**

The ISU Book Store, CELT, and faculty recently partnered on a study that examined the efficacy of CoachMe, a new tool which provides embedded practice exercises in student course e-books.
